It is requested to each National Federation having Continental Kata Judges to enter up at least one qualified Judge. The Seminar will be session for examination of new Continental Kata Judges in Nage-no-Kata, Katame-No-Kata and Kime-No-Kata or to extend the number of Kata licences to the Judges that have not licence for these Katas. Criteria for the Candidates: Minimum Age = 30 years old Minimum grade = 4th dan Each Candidate can be examined for 2 Kata. The examination will be based on: 1. Knowledge of the rules, written 2. Completing the scorecards, practical 3. Knowledge of the kata principles, practical on the mat 4. Knowledge of the attitude and organization The Candidates that passed the theoretical examination will be observed 1. and evaluated as Judges in the EJU Kata Tournament.
